

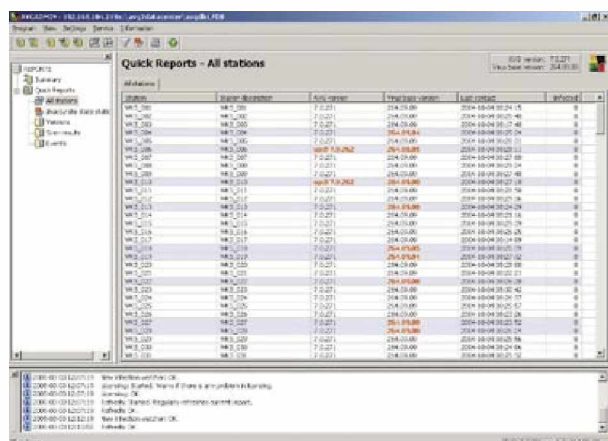

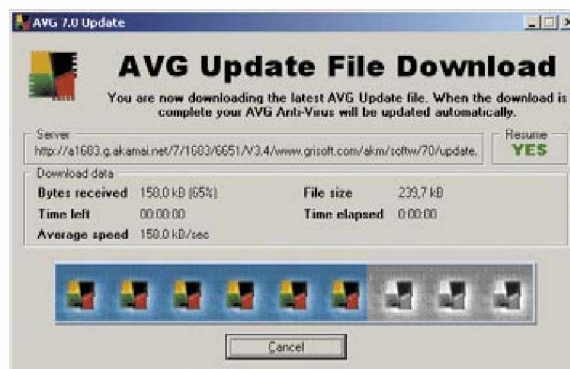

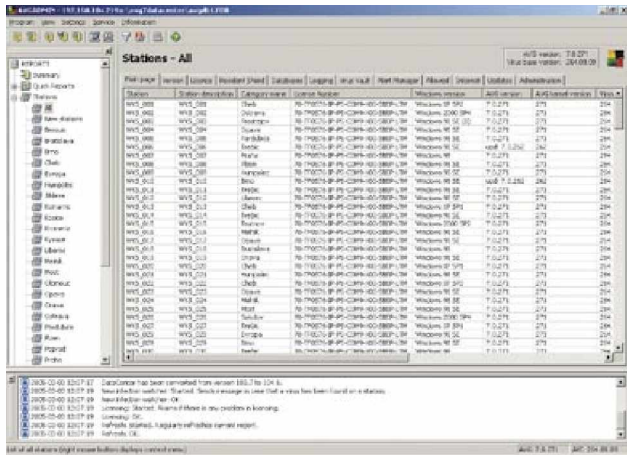

MANAGEMENT WITH AVGADMIN

AVGADMIN provides the tools to centrally install and configure AVG clients anywhere in the network, and manage updates from a local Web server or network directory. AVGADMIN is independent of the network (Microsoft, Novell, P2P, etc.) and server architecture, ensuring convenient administration in networks of any size. The tools support remote management of all clients in the local network – allowing the administrator to run tests, trigger virus and program updates, modify settings, and process data.



AVGADMIN Advanced Interface. Wide possibilities to configure anti-virus protection in networks, complete overviews about network protection status, all in hands of network administrators.

Central administration utilizes the DataCenter, which serves as the communication mechanism for updating client settings, test definitions and other system commands, virus alerts, and other information. The DataCenter can be configured to operate using a TCP server (recommended for most configurations) or other SQL servers.

LICENSING ALL YOUR WORKSTATIONS AND SERVERS

The AVG Network Edition is licensed according to the total number of workstations and file servers combined, including:

- All workstations on the network
- Workstations that are not running AVG but are connected to a file server that is using the AVG File Server Edition
- Workstations that are not on the network (e.g., remote offices) but have AVG installed on them
- Workstations that are connected to the network only part-time (e.g., notebook computer)

Configurations of 2, 5, 10, 15, 20, 25, 30, 40, 50, 75, and 100 licenses are available, as are larger configurations upon request. The standard license period is 2 years (vs. 1-year licenses of other anti-virus companies), giving you more time to work and less time to worry.
