

All About Licence Numbers

Step 1. Receive Licence Number email.

Once registered you will be emailed a “**licence number**” which should then be entered into the AVG software. In most cases, this licence number will be valid for two years. You will now need to enter this licence into your AVG software.

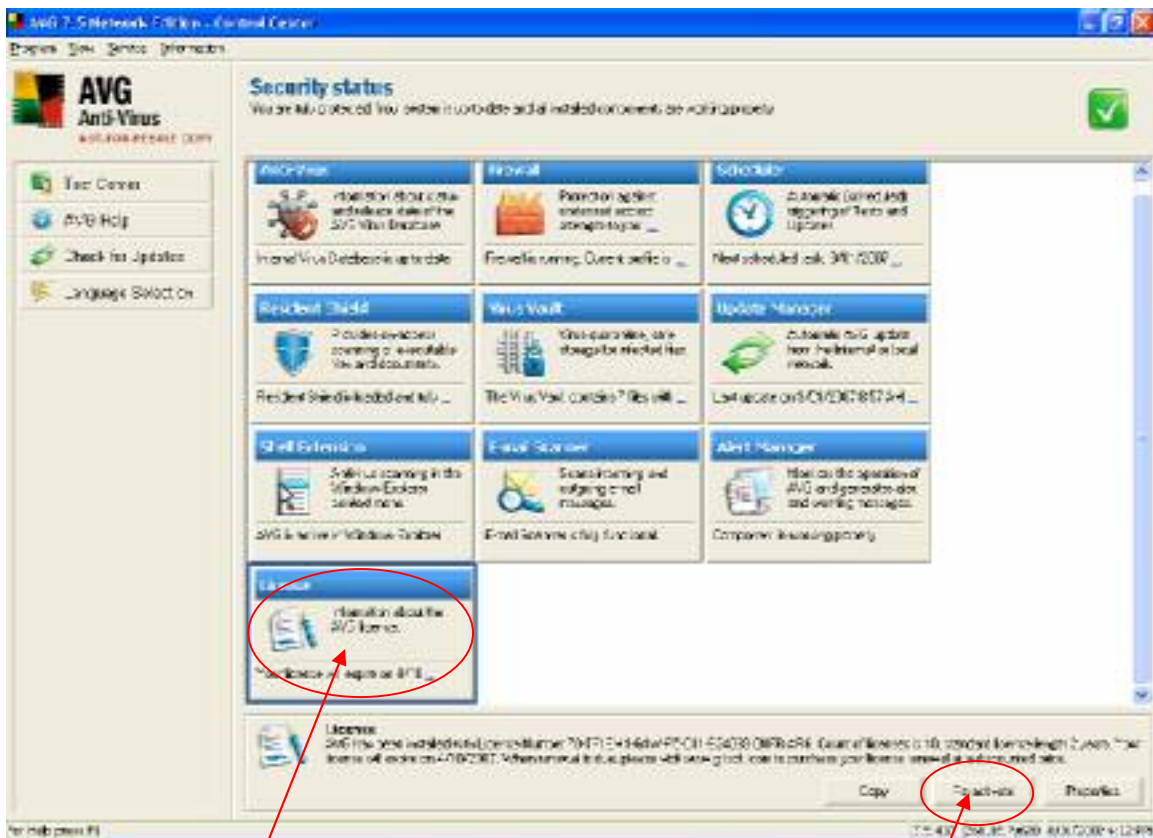
Step 2. Copy your licence number from within the email.

If you are not familiar with Windows Copy & Paste capability, for your convenience we have attached instructions at end of this document.

Step 3. Open AVG Control Centre

From the Start Menu (bottom left) open the Control Center:

Start / All Programs / AVG 7.5 Anti Virus / AVG Control Center



Select the Licence Board by clicking on it

Click the Re-activate button in the bottom part of the dialog window.

Step 4. In the Activate AVG window, fill in the empty boxes with your Name and, if relevant, company details.



Step 5. Enter Licence Number

Paste the licence number into the appropriate box.

We highly recommend “copying” and “pasting” as when typing, many people mix up the number “1” with the letter “l” and zero with the letter “O” leading to frustration and lack of success. If you are not familiar with Windows Copy & Paste capability, for your convenience we have attached instructions at end of this document.

Step 6. Press Activate Button

When the “Licence number” has been entered successfully, the License Board (see diagram in Step 3) will turn blue. You should now be licensed for two years.

That’s it! Your AVG Anti-Virus is now activated and registered in your name. This allows you to access technical support and provides you with access to the loyalty discount on renewal of your licence.

To Copy / Paste

Use your mouse to highlight the complete licence number, (to highlight the number, hold the left hand mouse button whilst moving the cursor over the rest of the code, release the mouse button when the code is fully covered) and “copy” this.

To copy you will need to hold the Control key (Ctrl on most keyboards) and then letter “C” whilst the Ctrl key is still depressed.

To paste you will need to hold the Control key and then the letter “V” whilst the Ctrl is still depressed.
